ACTIVITIES TO BE CONDUCTED

Moodjitch Binar Nyorps and Yorgas Introducing Noongar culture through early childhood role-play. An introduction to traditional Aboriginal culture through the role of an Indigenous child. Students will be engaged in hunting and gathering using traditional singing, dancing, face painting and jewellery making.

Koolangars, Corroborees and Kaleeps Participate in sustainable hunting and fishing methods. An excursion which takes students on a Noongar cultural journey through traditional language, ceremony, hunting and fishing. Students will learn how Aboriginal people survived using natural resources sustainably while caring for the environment.
